

eBooks are great for people who struggle to hold the weight of a print book or who need large print, as you can change the size to suit you. Some eBooks also have colour overlays to help you read easier with colour contrast.

You can access eBooks with your phone, tablet or laptop. For some platforms, you will need an internet connection to access an eBook, while other platforms allow you to download the eBook to your device so that you can read it later when you may not have internet access.

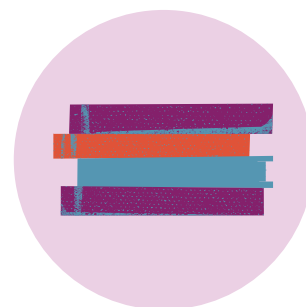

GET A LIBRARY APP

Both Stoke and Staffordshire Libraries have an electronic collection that allows you to read and listen to books online. You can sign up online or use your existing library account to use them.

The eBooks and audiobooks will work like normal library books, where you have a set period of time that you can use them and you may need to wait for others to finish reading before you can borrow them. However, you can also make requests and renew your books like normal library books too.
