All of these services are available for free as long as you have an internet connection or are able to download to your device (if allowed by the streaming services).

They have a collection of old content, new releases, films and catch up tv. You can also watch some live TV online with these services.

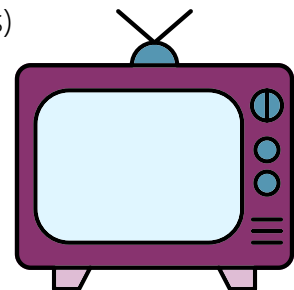
BBC iPlayer: No adverts apart from short ones about other TV shows.
Need TV licence to use

ITV Hub: contains adverts (you can pay monthly to not see ads)

All4: contains adverts. You can also pay monthly to not see adverts (except for short ones about other TV shows)

My5: contains adverts.

Honourable mention: YouTube - some TV content on YouTube is provided legally or as episode summaries or clips. But be careful of channels that direct you to other websites to watch things, or TV and films put on YouTube illegally.
